

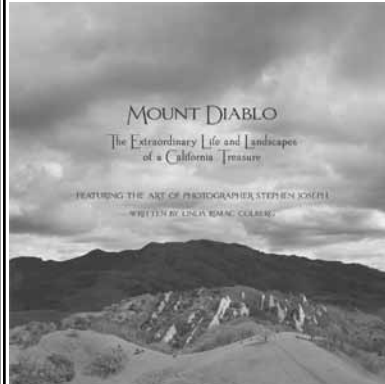

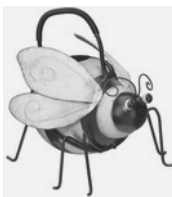

BIRDSCAPE YOUR GARDEN



BIRDSCAPING is the enhancement of your yard to improve the variety and number of birds. There are four basic elements needed to maximize your habitat's attraction to birds:

FOOD - Offer a wide variety of bird foods in different feeders and bird-friendly plants.
WATER - Birds need a dependable supply of water throughout the year for drinking and bathing.
COVER/SHELTER - Birds won't come to a feeder or bath unless they feel secure. They need protective cover to escape predators and in order to rest.
NESTING LOCATIONS - In addition to bird houses, trees, shrubs and other plants that provide shelter can be safe nesting areas.

We have a great naturalist who is willing to provide this Birdscaping service. Michael Marchiano has been our WBU Naturalist for the last few years. He leads our bird and nature walks and has put on many workshops in our Interpretive Center. He is very knowledgeable about birds, mushrooms, native plants, insects, spiders and reptiles found in the Bay Area and California. Mike will visit your home and analyze your habitat. He will give you specific recommendations for ways you can enhance your habitat to attract more birds, butterflies and insects. You will receive a drawing of your yard and a sketch of specific recommendations.

The cost is \$75.00 for a two hour consultation and report. You will receive a \$25.00 coupon that can be used at WBU to implement Mike's recommendations.

This is a wonderful Spring activity that will enhance your enjoyment of your yard.

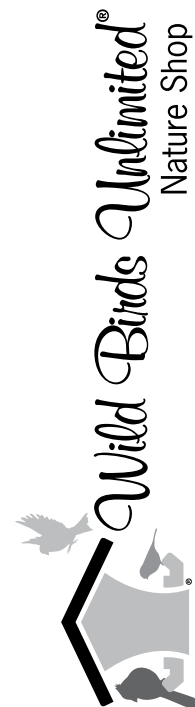

Don't be satisfied with being just a stop-over. Make your yard the place to be, for you and your birds.
